

CARNLOUGH, ANTRIM to DERRY/LONDONDERRY

Cameras at the ready! You're about to experience one of the most spectacular coastal drives; Northern Ireland's <u>Causeway Coastal</u> Route.

40,000 hexagonal basalt columns make up the **Giant's Causeway** (Fee Included), a **World Heritage Site**.

Choose to walk in the footsteps of mythical giant Finn McCool on a steep 1.6km (1 mile) descent/ascent. Or simply follow an accessible path to the Giant's Causeway viewing point.

Anyone for a wee dram? Visit **Bushmills**, the oldest licensed whiskey distillery in the world, for a tasting (Optional Extra).

Enjoy a self-guided tour at clifftop **Dunluce Castle** (Fee Included) before passing through historic gates to enter the city of **Derry/Londonderry**.





Overnight Stay ARNOLDS HOTEL



At the heart of Dunfanaghy village, family-owned Arnolds Hotel overlooks spectacular scenery in Donegal.

DERRY/LONDONDERRY to DUNFANAGHY, DONEGAL

Start the day with a guided historical walking tour along the walls of Ireland's only fortified city, **Derry/Londonderry** (Fee Included).

Cross the border back into the **Republic of Ireland** and the euro currency zone (€).

Visit <u>Grianán of Aileach</u>, a reconstructed **stone ringfort** with wonderful views that is marked on Ptolemy's 2nd century world map.

See pristine panoramas in lakeside <u>Glenveagh National Park</u>. Watch out for wild deer and eagles. Time permitting, take a self-guided tour of Glenveagh Castle (Optional Extra).

Stop on the shores of Sheephaven Bay to check out <u>16th century Doe</u> <u>Castle</u>, traditional home of the Sweeney Clan.

DUNFANAGHY, DONEGAL to DONEGAL TOWN

Today, we'll further explore **Donegal**; one of Ireland's most remote and beautiful regions.


With verdant valleys, golden sand beaches and rolling hills as far as the eye can see, we'll start the day with a scenic drive.

Eddie Doherty's hand-loomed tweed is inspired by his native Donegal landscape. Enjoy a **handweaving demo** in this artisan craft studio.

At Slieve League, choose one of these options:

- Admire these magnificent 600m/2000ft cliffs from a viewing platform.
- Board a 12 person capacity boat for a scenic 2 hour trip under the cliffs (Optional Extra). Weather dependent.

Watch shepherd and dog working perfectly in tandem during a **sheepdog demo** (Fee Included). On some departures, this experience can happen later in the itinerary.

After lunch, recite the magical verse of WB Yeats at Glencar Waterfall. This outstanding area of natural beauty inspired the Nobel Prize winning poet.

Lose a sin with every step on the holy mountain of **Croagh Patrick**. Nearby lies the ruined 16th century Murrisk Abbey and the National Famine Memorial.

Take a deep breath... Next is the **Doolough Valley**, one of Ireland's most scenic driving routes.

What's the classic postcard image of Ireland? We think you'll find it this afternoon amid the savage beauty of **Connemara**.

Take a self-guided tour of the beautiful **Kylemore Abbey** (Fee Included). Wander the wonderful walled garden — bananas were grown here in the 1800s! — or admire the enchanting neo-Gothic church.

Located right on the Atlantic Ocean in Clare, the Armada is one of our favourite hotel stops.

The Burren & Cliffs Of Moher



CLIFDEN, CONNEMARA TO SPANISH POINT, CLARE

Take a guided tour of 16th century **Aughnanure Castle**, ancestral home to the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included).

We're aiming for <u>Galway</u> next. The City of the Tribes is bohemian and buzzy.

Spot red-sailed traditional boats and picturesque **Dunguaire Castle** in the village of Kinvara, on Galway Bay.

Next is the bewitching beauty of **The Burren**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora.

Hold onto your hat! It's the world famous <u>Cliffs of Moher</u> (Fee Included). You'll be dazzled by these majestic 700 ft (215m) high sea cliffs.



Day 10: Tuesday 15 Day All Ireland Tour





DINGLE SKELLIG HOTEL



Soak in a rooftop hot tub with views over a spectacular bay at the Dingle Skellig Hotel.

SPANISH POINT, CLARE to DINGLE, KERRY

Drive along the **Clare** coastline with uninterrupted ocean vistas.

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in 'The Kingdom' of Kerry (Fee Included).

Tour a working Irish **sheep farm** with charming old-style cottages for a live **sheepdog demo** (Fee Included). On some departures, this activity may occur on Day 5.

Refresh yourself with an ice cold pint at the **South Pole Inn**. Relive the extraordinary deeds of its one time landlord, Antarctic explorer, Tom Crean.

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!



DINGLE SKELLIG HOTEL



Soak in a rooftop hot tub with views over a spectacular bay at the Dingle Skellig Hotel.

DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. This morning, soak up the charms of **Dingle**, with quality downtime or a choice between the following relaxed activities.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A, B or C):

- A. Take a **boat trip** around spectacular Dingle Bay.
- **B.** Savour a guided **craft tour** of the Dingle Crystal studio.
- **C.** Golfers will enjoy Dingle's excellent links course. This is an all day activity.

This afternoon, you have the option to experience **Slea Head**, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

Whatever you do in **Dingle**, don't miss an Irish traditional music session or a stroll around the town's plentiful art galleries and craft studios.



Day 12: Thursday 15 Day All Ireland Tour





THE MOORINGS HOTEL



Located harbourside in the picturesque village of Portmagee, the Moorings Guesthouse is the perfect base for exploring the Ring of Kerry.

Horse-Drawn Carriage Ride



DINGLE, KERRY to PORTMAGEE, KERRY

Start the day with a scenic drive along the coast of the **Dingle Peninsula**, with a photo stop and a stroll along the beach at Inch
Strand.

Take a **horse-drawn carriage ride** around **Killarney National Park** (Optional Extra).

Your visit to **Killarney National Park** may also include:

- Sightings of rare red deer herds in native oak forest
- 19th century Muckross House & Gardens
- A short walk to scenic **Torc Waterfall**
- Idyllic lakeside and mountain views

After lunch we'll stop at **Cahergall**, an ancient Irish stone fort built in the 7th century.

Good heavens! Kerry is a certified **International Dark Sky Reserve** with virtually no light pollution and often crystal clear night skies.









Feel right at home when you stay at this family-run townhouse in Kenmare near the Ring of Kerry.

Island Boat Trip & Ring Of Kerry



PORTMAGEE, KERRY to KENMARE, KERRY

Today is your chance to experience Ireland's island treasures; the Skelligs.

Take a **guided boat trip** around both **Skellig Islands** to experience seabirds and amazing history (Optional Extra). This cruise lasts 2 hour 30 minutes.

This is an ocean crossing. Departures are seasonal (mid-May to mid-September). The 12 person capacity boats are small. The cabin conditions are rough and wet; sea legs are required. Your departure is weather dependent and, as such, occasionally subject to late cancellation.

Landlubbers can still experience the Skelligs. Visit the Skellig **Experience** to learn all about Ireland's unique island treasures (Optional Extra).

Further along the Ring of Kerry, visit Derrynane, historic home to Daniel O'Connell (Optional Extra). Ramble to the golden sands of Derrynane beach.

Catch authentic traditional Irish music and outstanding local food tonight in lively **Kenmare**.







Located in a serene valley in Cork, Gougane Barra Hotel is a long-standing favourite with our guests.

MACROOM CASTLE HOTEL



Expect a warm Irish welcome at this locally-owned 4 star hotel in the village of Macroom in Cork.

KENMARE, KERRY to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Expect rugged roads and superb scenery as we explore the remote Beara Peninsula.

Of the four peninsulas in Ireland's southwest, the Beara receives the least amount of visitors and has the feeling of true wilderness.

Take a spin over either the **Caha** or **Healy Pass**, both dramatically scenic mountain roads on the Beara Peninsula.

Look out for seals on a scenic **boat trip** to **Garnish Island**. Once landed, explore the wonders of the Italian-style formal gardens (Optional Extra).

Visit stately **Bantry House & Gardens**, a grand Irish home built in the 18th century (Fee Included).

There's one more drive today, a coastal ride that snakes along Bantry Bay before cutting inland.

GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK to GRAND CANAL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye — $sl\acute{a}n$ in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

We'll trace the valley of the **River Lee**, crossing stone bridges and passing through picturesque countryside.

Then it's time to kiss the **Blarney Stone** (Fee Included). Afterwards, explore the extensive grounds and lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle**.

En route back to Dublin, enjoy a self-guided tour of the **Rock of Cashel** (Fee Included). Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here. It's an epic way to conclude our Irish odyssey.

You'll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell elbow bumps all round for your new travel buddies!


