

SALTHILL, GALWAY to DOOLIN, CLARE

Learn about the ancient art of harp making on a guided visit to the studio of traditional Irish harpist and musical woodworker, Brian Callan, located in **Galway** (Fee Included).

Next, we'll pass through the bewitching beauty of **The Burren**, with its limestone lunar landscape, ancient dolmens and uniquely rich flora.

Irish music sessions in pubs are rightly famous. But did you know that some of the most atmospheric and authentic traditional music performances happen at home? Today you'll find out why, with an intimate gig and historical talk in **Doolin Music House** (Fee Included); home of musician Christy Barry and artist Sheila Quinn.

Hold onto your hat! It's the **Cliffs of Moher** (Fee Included). You'll be dazzled by these majestic 700ft high sea cliffs.

This evening, you won't go far to find good tunes. The seaside village of **Doolin** is one of the true spiritual homes of Irish traditional music.

DOOLIN, CLARE to DINGLE, KERRY

Miltown Malbay is a hub for traditional music in Ireland. Step into the **Music Makers of West Clare** to learn about Irish music, song and dance, as well as how this small town became so important to the scene.

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in 'The Kingdom' of Kerry (Fee Included).

Meet champion dancer, Ranóg Townsend, for an **Irish dance workshop** (Fee Included). Learn the basic steps of *sean nós* dancing, the oldest traditional dance style in Ireland.

Visit a working Irish sheep farm with charming old-style cottages for a live sheepdog demo and guided farm tour (Fee Included).

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of food and music options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

DINGLE, KERRY to PORTMAGEE, KERRY

Dip your toes in the ocean at **Inch Strand**, a broad stretch of golden sand with rolling Atlantic waves.

Step back in time to visit an ancient ring fort on the **Iveragh Peninsula** and learn how how people lived in Ireland's Iron Age.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A or B):

- **A.** Take a guided boat trip around both **Skellig Islands** to experience seabirds and amazing history (Optional Extra). Duration: 2 hour 30 minutes. This is an ocean crossing. The 12 person capacity boats are small. Cabin conditions are rough and wet; sea legs are required. Your departure is weather dependent and subject to late cancellation.
- **B.** Savour a guided whiskey tasting and historical tour at the **Portmagee Distillery** (Optional Extra).

Enjoy live Irish music in an intimate setting tonight at The Moorings Bar in **Portmagee**.

PORTMAGEE, KERRY to BALLYVOURNEY, CORK

Start the day with a scenic coastal drive around the world famous **Ring of Kerry** touring route.

Visit **Derrynane House** to learn about Daniel O'Connell — a towering figure in Irish history — or take a stroll on one of Ireland's most pristine beaches.

Savour free time to explore the heritage town of **Kenmare**. Maybe you're ready to buy a traditional Irish instrument in the local music shop?

This afternoon, your Irish music tour turns towards the county of **Cork** and the remote village of **Ballyvourney**. This is an Irish-speaking Gaeltacht area, so ask your VagaGuide to teach you *cúpla focail*.

In **Ballyvourney**, enjoy yet another live traditional Irish music session in your hotel.







Nestled along a scenic curve of the river, just a brief stroll from the heart of Cork, The River Lee Hotel boasts an extraordinary location in this delightful and historically rich city.

Cork City & Blarney Castle



BALLYVOURNEY, CORK to CORK CITY

We'll first trace the valley of the **River Lee** downstream, crossing stone bridges and passing through postcard-pretty countryside.

Then it's time to — hygienically — kiss the **Blarney Stone** to gain the legendary gift o' the gab. You also have the option to amble through the lush, landscaped gardens surrounding Blarney Castle (Fee Included).

Take a music-centric walking tour of **Cork** with an expert local guide (Fee Included). Learn about the many famous musicians to emerge locally.

On your walking tour, you'll also pass some of Cork's best pubs for live music sessions.

This evening, you have the option of attending **Hysterical Histories** (Optional Extra). Hear the 800-year-old story of Cork city at this entertaining theatre experience.

CORK CITY to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Before we wave goodbye — $sl\acute{a}n$ in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

Take a self-guided tour of the **Rock of Cashel** (Fee Included). Saint Patrick christened the King of Munster here and Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland on this very spot.

You'll reach **Dublin** in your Mercedes tour vehicle around 3pm.

Take a rockin' guided tour of Dublin's **Windmill Lane Studios** (Optional Extra), a recording venue first made famous by U2. We think it's a fittingly epic place to draw your Irish music tour to a close.

Alternatively, feel free to opt for an early check-in at your hotel.
