This tour travels from **Dublin** to **Cork** before crossing into Kerry. Visit **Killarney National Park** and tour the **Ring of Kerry** before arriving in **Dingle**. See the Cliffs of Moher in **Clare** and then visit **Galway** and **Connemara**.

Blarney Stone & Rock Of Cashel



GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN to GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM, CORK

Meet your guide and fellow Driftwooders at the **Grand Canal Hotel**, **Dublin**, at least 15 minutes before your scheduled departure time of 8.20am. Board your Mercedes tour vehicle for the trip of a lifetime!

Take a self-guided tour of the **Rock of Cashel**. Saint Patrick converted the King of Munster here. Brian Boru was crowned High King of Ireland here. It's an epic way to begin your Irish odyssey.

Then it's time to — hygienically — kiss the famous **Blarney Castle** to gain the gift o' the gab. Afterwards, explore the lush, landscaped gardens of **Blarney Castle**.

Then we'll trace the valley of the **River Lee**, crossing stone bridges and passing through postcard-pretty countryside.

House Tour, Boat Trip & Island



GOUGANE BARRA or MACROOM to KENMARE, KERRY

Your morning will be spent exploring the many delights of **Bantry Bay**.

Visit stately **Bantry House**, one of the few grand Irish homes still in private hands; owned by the same family since the 18th century.

Look out for seals on a scenic boat trip to **Garnish Island**. Once landed, explore the wonders of the Italian-style formal gardens (Optional Extra).

Expect rugged roads and superb scenery as we explore the remote **Beara Peninsula**. Of the peninsulas in Ireland's southwest, the Beara receives the least amount of visitors and a feeling of true wilderness.

Take a spin over either the **Caha Pass** or the **Healy Pass**, both dramatically scenic mountain roads on the Beara Peninsula.

Located harbourside in the picturesque village of Portmagee, the Moorings Guesthouse is the perfect base for exploring the Ring of Kerry.

Horse Carriage Ride In Killarney



KENMARE, KERRY to PORTMAGEE, KERRY

Take a **horse-drawn carriage ride** around **Killarney National Park** (Optional Extra).

Your visit to Killarney National Park may also include:

- Sightings of rare red deer herds in native oak forest
- 19th century Muckross House and Gardens
- A short walk to scenic **Torc Waterfall**
- Idyllic lakeside and mountain views

This afternoon is your chance to experience the **Ring of Kerry** on the Iveragh peninsula.

Visit **Derrynane House**, historic home to Daniel O'Connell (Optional Extra). Afterwards, ramble to the nearby golden sands of Derrynane beach or hunt for fairies in local woodland.

Please be aware that your hotel in Portmagee on Day 3 does not have an elevator.

DINGLE SKELLIG HOTEL



Soak in a rooftop hot tub with views over a spectacular bay at the Dingle Skellig Hotel.

PORTMAGEE, KERRY to DINGLE, KERRY

Today is your chance to experience Ireland's island treasures; the **Skelligs**.

Take a **guided boat trip** around both Skellig Islands to experience seabirds and amazing history (Optional Extra). This cruise lasts 2 hour 30 minutes.

This is an ocean crossing. Departures are seasonal (mid-May to mid-September). The 12 person capacity boats are small. The cabin conditions are rough and wet; sea legs are required. Your departure is weather dependent and, as such, occasionally subject to late cancellation.

Landlubbers can still experience the Skelligs. Visit the **Skellig Experience** to learn all about Ireland's unique island treasures (Optional Extra).

Dingle awaits... Revel in a wealth of dinner and entertainment options in this bustling little town. There's a pub for every 40 residents!

DINGLE, KERRY to SLEA HEAD, KERRY (and return)

Today is yours to design. Soak up the charms of **Dingle**, with quality downtime or a choice between the following relaxed activities.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS (Choose A, B or C):

- A. Take a **boat trip** around spectacular Dingle Bay.
- **B.** Savour a guided **craft tour** of the Dingle Crystal studio (Fee Included).
- **C.** Golfers will enjoy Dingle's excellent links course. This is an all day activity.

Experience **Slea Head**, one of the most beautiful drives in Ireland. Rugged beauty and knife edge cliffs are guaranteed. Look out for the **Blasket Islands** and the holy **Mount Brandon** among the patchwork fields and picture-perfect cottages.

Whatever you do in **Dingle**, don't miss an Irish traditional music session or a stroll around the town's plentiful art galleries and craft studios.

Farm Tour & Sheepdog Demo



DINGLE, KERRY to SPANISH POINT, CLARE

After another hearty Irish breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to **Dingle**.

Visit a working Irish sheep farm with charming old-style cottages for a live **sheepdog demo** and **guided farm tour** (Fee Included). On some departures, this activity may happen on Day 8.

Look out for low-flying dolphins as we take a ferry across the mouth of the **Shannon** - the longest river in Ireland - to arrive in **Clare** (Fee Included).

Drive the west Clare coastline with uninterrupted ocean vistas and the Aran Islands lying only 8km (5 miles) offshore.

Overnight Stay ABBEYGLEN CASTLE HOTEL CONNEMARA



The romantic Abbeyglen Castle Hotel is steeped in charm and located near Clifden in Connemara.

Castle Stay & Cliffs Of Moher



SPANISH POINT, CLARE to CLIFDEN, CONNEMARA

Hold onto your hat! It's the Cliffs of Moher (Fee Included). You'll be dazzled by these majestic 700ft high sea cliffs.

Next is the bewitching beauty of **The Burren**. This region boasts a limestone lunar landscape and uniquely rich flora.

Spot red-sailed traditional boats and picturesque **Dunguaire Castle** in the village of Kinvara, on Galway Bay.

We're aiming for **Galway** next. The City of the Tribes is bohemian and buzzy.

Take a guided tour of 16th century **Aughnanure Castle**, ancestral home to the ferocious O'Flaherty clan (Fee Included).

CLIFDEN, CONNEMARA to GRAND CANAL HOTEL, DUBLIN

Before we say goodbye — $sl\acute{a}n$ in Irish — there's still time to take in some of Ireland's highlights.

Revel in the savage beauty of **Connemara**, famed for its traditional lrish culture, misty mountains, wild moorlands and dark lakes.

There's a quick photo stop at <u>Kylemore Abbey</u> – one of Ireland's most scenic historic buildings.

Explore the historic ruins of 15th century **Ross Errilly Friary** or the picturesque village of **Cong**, filming location for John Wayne's The Quiet Man.

You'll disembark your Drifter tour vehicle back at the Grand Canal Hotel in **Dublin** between 5-6pm. Farewell elbow bumps all round for your new friends.
